Revenue from the CP division increased by S\$1.51 million from S\$7.84 million in 2Q2006 to S\$9.35 million in 2Q2007. This was due to an increase in demand for our ship repair activities from major shipyards in Singapore and Batam.

Revenue from the IE division increased by \$\$7.79 million from \$\$4.69 million in 2Q2006 to \$\$12.48 million in 2Q2007. This increase was largely due to revenue contributions from the conversion and upgrading works of a floating production storage and offloading ("FPSO") vessel in Indonesia.

The increase in shipyard and rig building activities had a positive effect on the SD division resulting in an increase in demand for our hardware products. As a result, the SD division's revenue increased by S\$2.50 million from S\$5.46 million in 2Q2006 to S\$7.96 million in 2Q2007.

In view of the above, the Group's revenue increased by a total of S\$11.80 million from S\$17.99 million in 2Q2006 to S\$29.79 million in 2Q2007. This revenue increase is the main reason for the improved 2Q2007 earnings. As a result, the Group's net profits attributable to shareholders for 2Q2006 increased by 72% from S\$0.93 million in 2Q2006 to S\$1.59 million in 2Q2007.

The Group's turnover for the six months ended 30 June 2007 increased by 44% to \$\$50.08 million from \$\$34.69 million for the six months ended 30 June 2006. The increase in the Group's turnover was mainly attributable to the securing of higher value projects by the IE division and improved sales performance from the SD division.

The Group's net profits attributable to shareholders increased by 62% to \$\$2.77 million for the six months ended 30 June 2007 as compared to \$\$1.71 million for the previous corresponding period. The improved performance arose from the upside in marine and offshore oil and gas activities while maintaining administrative, selling and distribution expenses which led to better net profit margins and net earnings for the current financial period.

BALANCE SHEET REVIEW

Shareholders' funds increased from \$21.93 million as at 30 June 2006 to \$28.33 million as at 30 June 2007. This increase is due to the profits generated during the first six months of 2007 and the net proceeds raised through the issuance of 12 million new placement shares which was completed in February 2007.

Current assets and current liabilities as at 30 June 2007 increased by \$9.42 million and \$14.01 million respectively as compared to that of 31 December 2007. The current liabilities increased faster due to the short term bank borrowings for the acquisition of Water And Environmental Technologies (WET) Pte Ltd ("WET"). Excluding the investing activities, the increase in current assets and liabilities is in line with the rise in business activities during the financial period.

Non-current assets increased by \$11.13 million to \$20.96 million as at 30 June 2007 as compared to S\$9.83 million as at 31 December 2006. This increase comprises mainly provisional goodwill on consolidation arising from the aquisition of WET, and the provisional intellectual property rights owned by WET and its subsidiaries. The increase in fixed assets was due to the recent acquisition of a 32.8 hectare leasehold land, and leasehold improvement in Batam by PT Nexus Engineering Indonesia. The newly added fleet of air compressors acquired to support the increasing operational needs also contributed to the increase in non-current assets.

CASHFLOW STATEMENT

Of the S\$4.37 million which have been raised from the placement of 12 million new shares, the following amounts have been utilised;-

- (a) approximately S\$1.87 million for the acquisition of land in Batam, Indonesia;
- (b) approximately S\$1.5 million for the acquisition of 14,157,600 ordinary shares in the capital of WET; and
- (c) the balance of S\$1.0 million has been disbursed for working capital
