- Wet abrasive blasting technique relatively new in Asian region
- Addresses environmental and health concerns for the industry.
 - Reduces docking cost for customers

BKM is one of the largest and most established corrosion prevention players in South Asia with approximately S\$60 million annual revenue from its corrosion prevention segment. QFE operates

within the marine, oil and gas industries both on and off shore. Thus, provides its own manufactured and patented D-WAB systems for dust free surface preparation.

Both BKM and QFE will own a 50-50 stake in the new joint-venture company "Quill Marine Pte Ltd" (or "JVC"). A total investment of \$2million will use for the mass adoption and applications of wet abrasive blasting across the marine and offshore industries.

Wet Abrasive Blasting

Addressing environmental and health concerns

Wet abrasive blasting is a surface preparation technique involving systems where a mixture of abrasive and water is propelled by compressed air. It is relatively new in Asia as compared to dry abrasive blasting (using copper slag) although it can be used in most instances where dry abrasive blasting is used.

Employees who engage in abrasive blasting are at increased risk of exposure of toxic dusts, high noise levels, and a range of other safety and health hazards. Others may also be at risk if they work in the vicinity of areas where dry abrasive blasting is conducted.

With water added into the blasting process, the technique addresses concerns regarding environmental pollution of shipyards as it uses approximately 50% less abrasive grit, substantially lowering dust emission and the amount of containment required (compared to dry blasting).

Reduce dry-docking costs

Dry-docking a ship for repair can be costly for companies in terms of direct expenses relating to repair and maintenance expenses and indirect cost of lost revenue for the period when ship is docking.

The wet abrasive blasting system, allows simultaneous jobs to be performed on a docked ship, thus reducing repair turnaround time. The machines are also versatile, simple, and highly portable, and can be easily used for repair and maintenance work during voyages by crew.

"We hope to introduce wet abrasive blasting to the Asian region as it can still be considered relatively new. These new machines complement our core corrosion prevention business, as we will be able to provide another alternative to our customers' with different needs."
